***Oakridge Park Open and Safe for Use***

**HOLLYWOOD, FL** – Gather the kids, pack some snacks and head to Oakridge Park for an afternoon of fun and sun! Okaridge Park, located at 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Griffin and Stirling Roads, is open.

After being closed for approximately two weeks, Oakridge Park has reopened and is deemed safe for residents to walk their dogs, take a leisurely stroll or just relax while watching the children play on the playground equipment.

Several months ago, WPLG Channel 10 aired an investigative news story evaluating electrical power line networks. This report included The City of Hollywood's Oakridge Park and implied that power emission levels exceeded state mandates from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP).

In response to these concerns, the City of Hollywood engaged one of the most respected experts in this field to independently perform these same measurements and provide information regarding compliance levels with the state of FDEP standards. Results show the park is safe for residents.

Oakridge Park, a beautiful 37-acre park, was created in one day by DiamlerChrysler executives, City of Hollywood employees and civic association members. Amenities at the park include a playground, walking paths, a small pavilion, a play area for dogs and their owners and two parking lots.
