“A Moment of Remembrance” Set for Sept. 11 at 8:30 a.m.**

- WHAT:** “A Moment of Remembrance” to commemorate the 9-11 anniversary
- WHEN:** Monday, September 11, 2006 at 8:30 a.m.
- WHERE:** On the steps at Hollywood City Hall, located at 2600 Hollywood Boulevard
- OTHER:** The City of Hollywood will commemorate the 5<sup>th</sup> anniversary of 9-11 with a ceremony on the steps of City Hall. City employees will come together to remember the lives lost and pay tribute to the heroes who emerged on September 11, 2001.

Mayor Mara Giulianti will open the ceremony with a reflection of that tragic day in our Country’s history. In addition, the ceremony will include the Presentation of Colors by the City of Hollywood’s Honor Guard, the singing of *God Bless America* by Fire Rescue Division Chief Lamar Davis accompanied by Richard Turpin and the playing of TAPS by Police Detective Carlos Negron. A 9-11 memorial exhibit, created by Officer Artie Metzler, will be displayed.

A moment of silence will take place at 8:46 a.m., the time the first plane crashed into the north tower of the World Trade Center.
