***Proposed Project May Plants its Way onto Hollywood Beach***  
**A public meeting is set for February 8th for dune/sea oat planting program**

**HOLLYWOOD, FL** – Along with palm trees and other native flora, Hollywood Beach may be the home of a new dune/sea oat planting program. The City of Hollywood will be hosting a public meeting to inform its residents of the proposed program on Thursday, February 8, 2007. The meeting will be held at the Hollywood Beach Culture and Community Center.

Beach dunes contain plants that can tolerate salt spray. They will be planted along certain sections of Hollywood Beach as a defense against wind from storms, salt water and beach erosion

The meeting will include a presentation explaining the detailed agenda and scope of the project from representatives of the Broward County Soil and Water Conservation District. Engineering consultants from Miller Legg will also be present to answer any questions or concerns residents may have.

All residents are encouraged to attend, and the meeting is located at 1301 South Ocean Drive, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
